

fatik

fatik stands for fatigue. we gave the fatik shorts the style of pockets you find on fatigue pants and released them in orange and black. the ash, pine, and blush rennsweats came back alongside them, plus both denim colorways.

the orange pair would go on to become one of the pieces that never restocks.

the pocket reference gives fatik its name and its main design connection: the shorts translate a detail associated with fatigue pants into a shorter garment. orange and black offer two distinct versions of that idea. the relationship to the earlier rennshorts is in the fit, with fatik carrying the short format into a different visual direction.

the release was not limited to the new shorts. ash, pine and blush rennsweats and both nostalgia denim colorways returned with them, placing the new product beside established pieces. that combination keeps the drop connected to our wider catalog while giving the fatik shorts a clear introduction of their own. the release list below records the assortment at launch, rather than present-day stock.
